Happy New Year! The Arena Polo Season is in full swing for many of you and we are preparing for the series of senior school's competitions to be held at Longdole Polo Centre. This year we are again going to play the tournaments "off the stick" (i.e. no handicaps) but you do need to fill in your players' arena and outdoor handicaps for the purpose of seeding. Also this year no spurs will be allowed at any level. We strongly recommend that your school, players & parents look at the HPA rules regarding headgear, knee pads & goggles. (See P. 291 in the Blue Book)

Please note that all the tournaments are THREE - A - SIDE, including the Novice tournament which is for new players playing their first year of polo. Players must be mounted on polo ponies ("fluffies" may be used in the Novice Section) for three chukkas. All players in the teams must be in full time education at the same school and be over 13 years of age on 1st January 2007.

We were heavily oversubscribed last year so please try and spread your players out over your various teams and the various tournaments. As usual your 'A' team players may only play in the National Tournament (unless they are girls). The National Tournament is for all schools to enter their 'A' team whatever their standard - they are seeded carefully and so all teams should have an enjoyable day. The Intermediate Tournament is for 2nd teams and lower. Please note that this year the Novice Tournament is 3 A SIDE and will be played AFTER the Junior Schools Tournament. This means that due to time and light a maximum of 8 teams only can be accepted.

Please make sure that all your players have HPA Junior Membership. The HPA year runs from 1st April - 31st March so if a player paid and played last summer they are covered until 31st March 2007. The insurance is a separate cheque and goes directly to the HPA c/o Sophie Mcpherson. This is not personal health insurance, therefore your school and / or parents may need to look into this area.
