It is incredibly important that you read all the information in this letter and pass it on to everyone attending (including parents, horse hirers, coaches etc).

Start Time

Both arenas will start at 10 am promptly. Indoor will be Beginners, Novice Blue & Red & Novice (Ladies). Outdoor will be all Intermediates, Senior Open and the finals of the Beginner Division.

Beginners, Novice Blue & Red will all play 3 x 6 min chukkas.
Ladies Novice will play 4 x 4.5 min chukkas.

All Intermediate teams will play 3 x 6 min chukkas.
Senior Open teams will play 4 x 6.5 min chukkas.

All teams are expected to be mounted and in the warmup arena a minimum of 1 chukka before their match. If any team/player holds up play due to not keeping an eye on the App they will find that their team has a goal awarded against them.

We are paper free, and all times and scores will be live on the PlayPolo App. Please ensure that you have downloaded the app before your arrival at Rugby Polo Club.

We have attached chukka lists with numbers & times, please note the times are purely a guide, it is your responsibility to keep an eye on the app. If a score has been entered it means the next chukka has commenced.

All teams are required to stay for prize giving at the end of the day approx. 15.50.

Play Polo App

The 'Play Polo' app is available in the App Store for both Android and Apple or you can follow the link here: <https://unitedpolo.page.link/mujE>

Once downloaded, you will need to select SUPA from the Club search option. Within the app, by pressing the trigram icon (three parallel lines) in the top left-hand corner, open the side bar menu where you will find more tournament information.

Hats - all hats must meet HPA requirements and be tagged with the SUPA hat tag (blue) please visit RJ Polo to get this done before getting on any ponies. You will not be allowed to play if your hat is not tagged with the blue SUPA tag.
